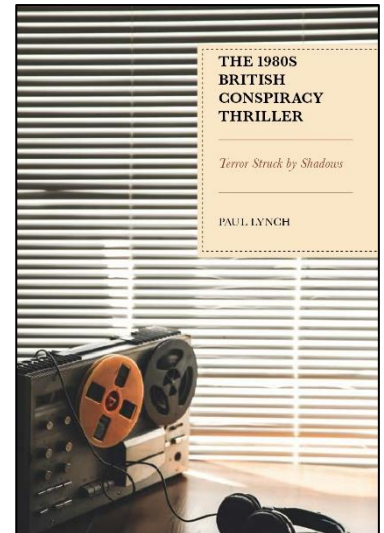

The first, charts the development of the conspiracy thriller genre by examining a wide range of conspiracy texts from both Hollywood and Europe (specifically, France and Italy). Thereafter, the second part is a deep dive into the British conspiracy genre, focusing on a range of key novels, films and television series that deal with the theme of conspiracy.

The list contains a variety of websites with articles about conspiracy.
